## Executive summary – Taiwan

- Most of Taiwan wants green energy.
  - 89% believe it is important to create a world fully powered by renewable energy, regardless of age, education level or political ideology.
- Support for renewable energy is especially rooted in:
  - National pride about technology leadership. 77% say they will be proud if Taiwan
    invests time and money to become a global leader in green energy.
  - Concern about climate change. 86% believe climate change is a global challenge, making it the most pressing global challenge in Taiwan.
  - **Economic benefits**. **71%** say building and producing more green energy will boost economic growth.
  - Societal benefits. 67% say there would be a reduction in health issues if their country was a leader in green energy.
- People in Taiwan want their country to increase usage of a variety of renewable energy types including solar, offshore wind and onshore wind.
