

Executive summary – Taiwan

- Most of Taiwan wants green energy.
 - **89%** believe it is important to create a world fully powered by renewable energy, regardless of age, education level or political ideology.
- Support for renewable energy is especially rooted in:
 - **National pride about technology leadership. 77%** say they will be proud if Taiwan invests time and money to become a global leader in green energy.
 - **Concern about climate change. 86%** believe climate change is a global challenge, making it the most pressing global challenge in Taiwan.
 - **Economic benefits. 71%** say building and producing more green energy will boost economic growth.
 - **Societal benefits. 67%** say there would be a reduction in health issues if their country was a leader in green energy.
- People in Taiwan want their country to increase usage of a variety of renewable energy types including **solar, offshore wind and onshore wind.**
